

Anti-Ubiquitin Monoclonal Antibody

BACKGROUND

Ubiquitin, a small protein comprised of 76 amino acids with a molecular mass of approximately 8.5 kDa, is highly conserved among eukaryotic species. The primary role of ubiquitin is to clear abnormal, foreign, and improperly folded proteins by targeting them for degradation by the 26S proteasome. Ubiquitination of proteins is an essential process that is regulated by ubiquitin-activating enzymes, ubiquitin-conjugating enzymes, and ubiquitin-protein ligases. Ubiquitination also occurs in the internalization and degradation of plasma membrane proteins.

SPECIFICITY

This antibody recognizes human, mouse, rat, and bovine ubiquitin. Other species have not been tested.

APPLICATIONS

Immunoblotting: use at 1ug/ml. A band of ~8.5 kDa is detected.

ELISA: use at 1ug/ml.

These are recommended concentrations. User should determine optimal concentrations for their application.

Positive control: HeLa cell lysate

DILUTION INSTRUCTIONS

Dilute in PBS or medium which is identical to that used in the assay system.

STORAGE AND STABILITY

This antibody is stable for at least one (1) year at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
