

Phytanoyl-CoA 2-hydroxylase (PHYH / PAHX) Monoclonal Antibody

BACKGROUND

The *PHYH* gene codes for the enzyme phytanoyl-CoA 2-hydroxylase which is critical for the normal function of peroxisomes. One substance broken down in peroxisomes is phytanic acid, a type of fatty acid obtained primarily from beef and dairy products. Phytanoyl-CoA 2-hydroxylase is responsible for one of the first steps in breaking down phytanic acid via alpha-oxidation. In subsequent steps, additional enzymes in peroxisomes and other parts of the cell further process this compound into smaller molecules that are utilized as sources of energy. Phytanoyl-CoA 2-hydroxylase may have other functions in addition to its role in breaking down phytanic acid; it appears to help determine the number of peroxisomes within cells and is involved in regulating their activity.

SPECIFICATION SUMMARY

Antigen: Fusion protein corresponding to aa 1-338 (full-length) of human PHYH. This sequence is 78% identical in rat and 78% identical in mouse.




APPLICATIONS

Immunoblotting: use at 1-5ug/ml. A band of ~40kDa is detected.



Detection of PHYH in rat brain lysate with #13825 at 5ug/ml.

Immunofluorescence: use at 10ug/ml.



Detection of PHYH in neuroblastoma cell line SK-N-BE with #13825 at 10ug/ml: DAPI (blue) nuclear stain, Texas Red F actin stain, ATTO 488 (green) PHYH stain.

These are recommended concentrations. Endusers should determine optimal concentrations for their application.



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DILUTION INSTRUCTIONS

Dilute in PBS or medium that is identical to that used in the assay system.

STORAGE AND STABILITY
