

Anti-IKKβ **Antibody**

BACKGROUND

Nuclear factor kappa B (NF-κB) is a ubiquitous transcription factor and key mediator of gene expression during immune and inflammatory responses. NF-κB activates numerous genes in response to extracellular stimuli, such as IL-1, TNF α , and LPS. NF-κB is associated with IκB in cytoplasm, which inhibits NF-κB activity. IκB kinase (IKK), which phosphorylates IκB and mediates IκB degradation and NF-κB activation, was recently identified. IKK is a serine protein kinase, and the IKK complex contains alpha and beta subunits (IKK α and IKK β). IKK α and IKK β interact with each other, and both are essential for NF-B activation. IKK β phosphorylates both I κ B- α and $I\kappa B$ - β and is expressed in a variety of human tissues.

SPECIFICATION SUMMARY

Antigen: Peptide corresponding to aa 662-680 of human IKK β which differs from the corresponding murine sequence

by one amino acid.

Host Species: Rabbit **Stabilizers:** None

Preservatives: 0.02% sodium azide.

SPECIFICITY

This antibody recognizes human IKK β (87 kD). No cross-reactivity with IKK α or IKK γ .

APPLICATIONS

Immunoblotting: use at 1:500-1:1,000

dilution.

Positive control: Whole cell lysate from

Jurkat cells.

DILUTION INSTRUCTIONS

Dilute in PBS or medium which is identical to that used in the assay system.

STORAGE AND STABILITY

This antibody is stable for at least one (1) year at -20°C. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
